

All students must pay fees or make arrangements to pay fees at the time of enrolment. There are a number of options available to assist with managing your payments.

The Student tuition fees are indicative only and are subject to change given individual circumstances at enrolment. Additional fees may apply such as student service and resource fees

The fees that you pay at enrolment are made up of:

Course Fees: The course fee is the sum of fees for all units that a student enrolls in, and is calculated as per the VET Fees & Charges Policy.

Resources Fees: Resource fees are charges for materials that are considered essential to a course or unit of study and which do not form part of the course fee. The resource fee covers materials purchased by the RTO to be consumed or transformed by students in the course of instruction.

Other Fees: This fee is charged to cover goods or services that are not essential to the course such as student ID cards, security services, etc.

Please note:

- » These fees are estimates only for students enrolling in government funded course in 2017 on a full-time basis unless otherwise stated
- » The approximate fees detailed below may differ between training providers due to the elective units they have included in the course outline
- » The approximate fees detailed below may differ for each individual depending on the units of study selected, prior education qualifications and recognition or prior work experience/learning
- » These differences generally result from adapting course to meet local industry needs. The actual costs of a course will also vary if different electives are chosen by the student
- » Concessions and annual course fee caps may also apply
- » Fees have been quoted on the basis of 2017 fee rates.
- » This document is accurate at the time of publication (April 2017). Course information and fees are subject to change without notice.
- » For secondary school ages persons (born on or after 1 July 1997 and must be at least 15 years old), the maximum tuition fee chargeable in 2017 is \$420. This maximum applies to the total tuition fees for one or more courses
